

PDRC Client Mediation Fees & Policies

Our mission is to provide mediation services to Clallam & Jefferson Counties. Attached you will find our standard fee schedule as well as our sliding fee schedule based on updated 2026 Federal Poverty Level Guidelines. It is our practice to serve all clients regardless of ability to pay.

FAMILY & COMMUNITY MEDIATIONS

Dissolution of marriage, creation or modification of parenting plan, HOA, neighborhood disputes, business disputes, and any other mediatable dispute.

*Each party pays their own fees for mediation. All fee negotiations are confidential and not shared with the other person.

Mediation Session Fee

\$40 Non-refundable Intake/Administration Fee.
\$150 Mediation Session Fee Per Party.

*This pays for a mediation session up to three hours.

Additional Mediation Session Fee

\$125 Mediation Session Fee Per Party.

*Second and following session fee, up to 3 hours.

CONFLICT COACHING

\$50 for a 1.5-hour session if requested as a standalone service outside of mediation.

*Conflict coaching occurring within mediation is a complementary service at no additional cost to the participating party.

WORKPLACE MEDIATIONS

\$100 Non-refundable Intake/Administration Fee.
\$300 Mediation Session Fee (\$150/person).

*Reduced rates available based on individual circumstances of organization.

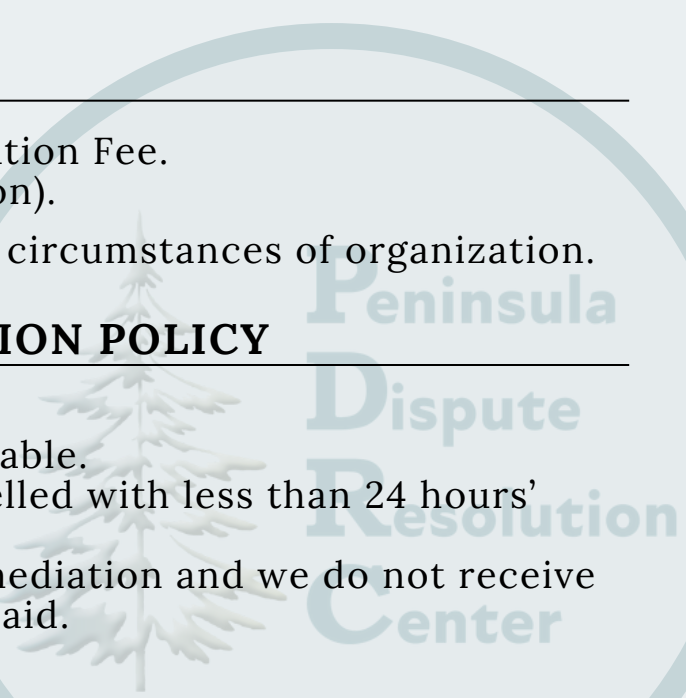
REFUNDS, NO-SHOWS, & CANCELLATION POLICY

*Mediation session fees are refundable.

*Intake/Administration Fees are non-refundable.

*\$40 cancellation fee if mediations are cancelled with less than 24 hours' notice at Executive Director's discretion

*If one or both parties do not show for the mediation and we do not receive contact, the agency will keep the full fee/s paid.



PDRC Sliding Fee Schedule

SLIDING FEE SCHEDULE

Our sliding fee schedule is based on Federal Poverty Level guidelines. Low-income individuals may apply for reduced rates, the fee schedule determines reduced rates. We will NEVER turn a client away based on ability to pay. Please talk with your intake coordinator if you have any concerns about cost.

PDRC Group Facilitations & Trainings

GROUP FACILITATIONS & TRAININGS

Facilitations

3-8 people = \$1,400 or *Non-profit = \$1,200

9-12 people = \$1,600 or *Non-profit = \$1,400

12+ people = hourly rate, would be discussed on a case-by-case basis

*Cost covers intake with organization lead, planning the facilitation, and a 6-hour facilitation.

Trainings

Customizable Full-Day Training (6 hour) = \$1,000 or *Non-profit = \$800

Customizable Partial-Day Training (4 hours) = \$500 or *Non-profit = \$400

*Cost covers intake with organization lead, planning, and facilitation of training.

*These services are by contract with the entity/organization. The total cost includes intake services by coordinator, intake interview by Certified Mediator/Group Facilitator(s), planning of training or facilitation, and strategy during event. This takes 16+ minimum hours of strategic planning, often more. The price does not change if more time is spent.

*Qualifying non-profits may be eligible for reduced rates at the Executive Director's discretion.
